## **ORDINANCE NO. 3**

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE SOUND VOLUME PRODUCED BY RADIO, TAPE PLAYER, OR OTHER MECHANICAL SOUND-MAKING DEVICE OR INSTRUMENT FROM WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MOLENA AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

It is ordained by the City of Molena as follows:

<u>SECTION ONE:</u> It is unlawful for any person to operate or amplify the sound produced by a radio, tape player, or other mechanical sound-making device or other instruments within the city limits of the City of Molena so that the sound is plainly audible at a distance of 100 feet or more from the source thereof.

SECTION TWO: The measurement of sound by law enforcement personnel shall be according to rules and standards promulgated by the Georgia Department of Public Safety which define "plainly audible."

<u>SECTION THREE:</u> Penalties. Every person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

<u>SECTION FOUR:</u> Repeal. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
